The didactic component of this program will be delivered utilizing Vista WebCT delivery format. Access to WebCT is virtually 24/7. The coursework adheres to the same rigorous standards as our on campus component. Coursework will be completed within the semester timeframe. It is during the semester timeframe and while the student is registered for a particular class that the practicum component will be fulfilled. Competencies (clinical rotations) are completed during this time. The training must be completed at the student's work facility or other approved clinical site. For this to take place, the assistance of a mentor or other facilitator is required. The facilitator will **not** serve as a full-time clinical instructor, but should be available to answer questions, evaluate core laboratory competencies, and give valuable assistance as needed. Various mentors may be utilized dependent upon the organization and size of our facility. Dependent on the applicant's skill level and work experience the time involved for mentors will vary for each course.

At the beginning of each course, the student will be given a list of clinical competencies that must be met to successfully complete the course. The student and the clinical facility should discuss scheduling times for the student to complete the required tasks.

Prior to being accepted into the AASU Medical Technology on-line program, the student must obtain a statement of support indicating the employer understands this responsibility.
